Bethany House Volunteer

Bethany House is a Catholic Worker House of Hospitality providing shelter to homeless women and their children. St. Joseph's has a long-term relationship with Bethany House to assist women in their re-entry to the community.

There are a variety of ways to help at Bethany House including providing Monthly Meals or Administrative Support. A rotating team of 4-5 people bring a fully prepared meal each month or occasionally re-stock the food shelf, help out on a shift.

What's expected?

Monthly Meal:

- Provide part of a meal on the 3rd Wednesday of month
- Re-heat food, set up buffet
- Serve residents
- Clean up the kitchen
- Dine and interface with residents

Administrative Support

- Re-stock the food cupboard
- Assist with other administrative activities as needed

Talents needed:

- Gracious hosting
- Warm welcoming demeanor
- Compassion
- Non-judgmental
- Good communication skills
- Relating well with marginalized women

Time commitment:

- Term – no limit
- Meetings - none
- Training – minimal, will be provided when you arrive at Bethany House

Benefits: Volunteers have the opportunity for a broadened understanding and experience with marginalized women. The Bethany community benefits from the sharing of personal resources and reaching out with love and support to challenged women trying to re-enter society.
