#### *What's expected:*

- Small group training session, including faith sharing and mentoring (written guidelines and directions are provided)
- Read Sunday readings each week using parish Question of the Week
- Check in early at your assigned mass with the Mass Coordinator
- Serve the host or precious blood to parishioners in communion procession
- Opportunities to serve at prayer services, Holy Days and Christmas/Easter Masses
- Participation at mass on a regular basis and occasional bible study and general spiritual gatherings

#### *Talents needed:*

- Having completed the Sacrament of Baptism, First Eucharist and Confirmation
- Dependability with a serious commitment to the ministry
- Available some weekends
- Ability and willingness to learn and love of the Mass
- Open to mentoring conversations

#### *Time commitment:*

- Scheduled on a regular basis, usually once every 5-6 weeks

*Benefits – Personal spiritual growth, sharing your love and the presence of Christ in the Eucharist with others, and inspiring spiritual renewal and a call to holiness to each person*
