  2. submit the fee payment electronically via a credit card or by mailing a check to the office. *Checks should be made out to St. Joseph's Faith for Life.*

### SUMMER REGISTRATION

The Summer Session is an intensive traditional classroom style of Faith Formation for grades kindergarten through 5th. During the 30 hours of instruction in this two-week period, children complete one full year of catechesis: daily attendance for all three lessons is important.

MATERIAL COST: **SUMMER FAITH FORMATION: \$75 per child.** All other offerings: \$50 per child for each offering. Fee for Youth Group to be determined.

## FAITH FORMATION OFFERINGS FOR 2018-2019

*All Faith for Life offerings provide opportunities for families to learn together. Parents are the best teachers of faith. Our mantra is that if we as adults are not learning and seeking God in our lives, how can we expect faith to take root in the hearts of our children? The Diocese of Rochester requires that each Faith Formation offering provides 30 hours of catechetical instruction.*

### SUMMER FAITH FORMATION, GRADES K-5

This is an intensive traditional classroom style of Faith Formation for **grades Kindergarten through 5th**. The session begins on Sunday July 8, 2018 at the 11am Mass with a family Welcome and Orientation to follow. It continues for the children Monday through Friday July 9 to July 20 from 8:45 am to noon, and includes a closing Mass on Friday. *An adult family member is required to volunteer in each child's class at least one morning during the summer session.*

This intensive two-week session is only one part of your family's ongoing faith development which includes regular participation in Sunday Eucharist, and involvement in the various Faith Formation activities offered throughout the year. Families participating in summer faith formation are encouraged to join any of our other Faith for Life offerings during the year without additional material costs.

### SCHOOL YEAR FAITH FORMATION, GRADES K-5

**Wednesdays, 6:15 P.M. - 7:30 P.M.**

This is a classroom-style of Faith Formation for grades Kindergarten through 5. Children meet on several Wednesdays each month from mid-September through early May. Family events to enrich the family's experience of learning in faith together are an integral part of this Faith Formation offering. This is a collaborative learning experience, and as parents are the first and best catechists of their children, you are invited to take a more active role with an enhanced family presence, activities for the home, and participation in monthly family sessions.


### GATHERED FAMILY FAITH, GRADES K-5

All families are welcome to consider two options featuring the gathering of several families to learn together. In addition to the use of your family Bible, a Catholic Catechism and other resources will be made available for each family. *One format gathers "at St. Joseph's," facilitated by parents with staff; the other gathers "in the home," facilitated by parents in collaboration with Faith for Life staff.* Gathered Family Faith gathered at St. Joseph's will meet on Sunday afternoons following the 11AM mass. Families wishing to explore the At Home option will meet with staff to determine if this option is a good fit for your family. All families continue learning at home between gathered sessions with materials provided by St. Joseph's.

### Youth Nights - YOUTH MINISTRY, GRADES 6-12

Our goal is to provide an experience of prayer, faith formation, service and community building so that youth are empowered to take ownership of the way they live out their faith each day. Parent involvement is an integral part of Youth Ministry. Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation will be integrated with the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum.
